



Acceptable Airline Crates

Crates must; be constructed of rigid plastic, wood or metal sturdy enough to resist bending when firm pressure is applied, have a solid roof with no doors or ventilations openings, have only one door made of metal which must close securely, yet allow pets to be accessible in the event of an emergency, have crate hardware that is in good working condition, have a nut and bolt firmly tightened in each hole that connects the top and bottom of the crate. The bolt must be made of metal. The nut may be metal, nylon or plastic as long as the nut is unbreakable and securely connects the top and bottom of the crate.
